## WE CAN

- Reduce your mental health appointment copays to \$10/visit
- Help you apply for insurance

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Parents of dependent children (birth—age 25)
- Children, teens, and young adults through age 25
- Household income at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Guideline
  - A single person with an income of \$31,225 or below
  - A family of two with an income of \$42,275 or below
  - A family of three with an income of \$53,325 or below
  - A family of four with an income of \$64,375 or below
