We are thrilled that you are interested in applying for a scholarship and are available to assisting you throughout the application process. Each year, scholarships are awarded to deserving students who are beginning their nursing education, and nurses who are looking to advance their nursing careers. **We want to especially invite nurses who have a passion for children's mental health.**

Our nurse scholars are making a difference in our community every day. **Since 2003, LOHF has provided over \$887,700 in tuition scholarships for 240 Lancaster County nursing students** whose work as nurses elevates the mental wellbeing of youth and children in Lancaster County.

Scholarship Program Requirements:

- Applicants must be permanent residents of Lancaster County at the time of application, OR working in healthcare in Lancaster County
- Applicants must already be admitted to a nursing education program at time of application
- Scholarships are for tuition costs only. Students receiving 100 percent employer tuition reimbursement should not apply
- By accepting a nurse education scholarship from LOHF, the scholarship recipient agrees to work full time in nursing in Lancaster County for each year of scholarship support awarded

Who is Eligible?

Practical or registered nursing students who are residents of Lancaster County and attend one of the following schools in Lancaster County:

- Harrisburg Area Community College-Lancaster Campus
- Lancaster County Career and Technology Center
- Pennsylvania College of Health Sciences
- Eastern Mennonite University-Lancaster Campus

Licensed nurses who are residents of Lancaster County and attend any RN to BSN, BSN, master, post-master, or doctoral program and certification classes, including but not limited to: school nurse, lactation consultant, and others requiring education.
